The MY-YU BUS runs from JR Kochi Station to Katsurahama, letting passengers visit a variety of travel destinations (Harimaya Bridge, Makino Botanical Garden, Chikurin-ji Temple, Katsurahama Beach, and more).



### C Kochi Castle

The castle was built in 1601 by Katsutoyo Yamauchi, the first lord of the Tosa domain. It is one of the existing 12 castles in Japan that still have a castle tower from the Edo period. 15 buildings, including Honmaru Palace and Ote-mon Gate, are designated as National Important Cultural

# This is a tourist information center for the entirety of Kochi Prefecture, and a good place for selfies, with the statues of the three Tosa samurai on the grounds. You might also catch a Yosakoi dance staged here on Saturdays, Sundays, or holidays. This museum exhibits precious materials traced back to the Yamauchi clan who ruled the Tosa Domain (the area that is now Kochi Prefecture), allowing visitors to experience National Treasures and Important Cultural Properties firsthand.
